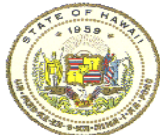
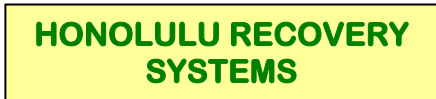
- Scrap metal, bicycles, appliances
